Typhoon Warnings: Procedure and Awareness Information

Osaka:

①If the storm warning is in effect at 7 o'clock, regular classes will be postponed in the morning and we will wait to see how the situation develops.
②If the storm warning has been canceled by 9 o'clock, all students are required to come to school and all classes will commence for the day.
③If the storm warning hasn't been canceled by 9 o'clock, classes will be temporarily suspended.
④When the students are already at school before the storm warning announcement we will send students home immediately.
Please note on instructions $\bigcirc \sim \bigcirc$, including \bigcirc , school lunch will be canceled for the day and no lunches will be delivered to the students. Hence, an equivalent amount of 1 day-mea shall be reimbursed.
Note for ②: If the storm warning has been canceled even when students are already at school, no school lunches will still be delivered and therefore are required to bring their own packed lunch or 'bento'. Henceforth, school store/cafeteria will also be closed for the day.
2. What to do when there is heavy rains, severe thunderstorms and flooding
①As a general policy, our school will have our regular school day. On a safety note, students are advised to take safety precautions upon coming to school and are recommended to leave home until the weather condition has calmed down. Late or tardiness will be excused during a very severe weather.
